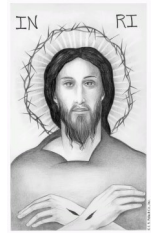

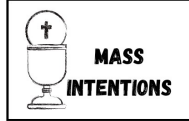

## Eucharistic Revival: Introduction to the Mass #4—Gesture

“Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.” 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 NIV

When non-Catholics attend the Mass, one of the common comments is that Catholics have a lot of movement in their worship: sitting, standing, sitting, standing, kneeling, standing, etc. Some have jokingly called it “Catholic Calisthenics.” However, this is actually a very profound spiritual point. Just as Jesus took on flesh at the incarnation, so too our prayer is incarnational. We pray with our bodies. And so we stand to honor the Gospel, we kneel in adoration of Jesus in the Eucharist. When we pray, we pray with the totality of who we are.
