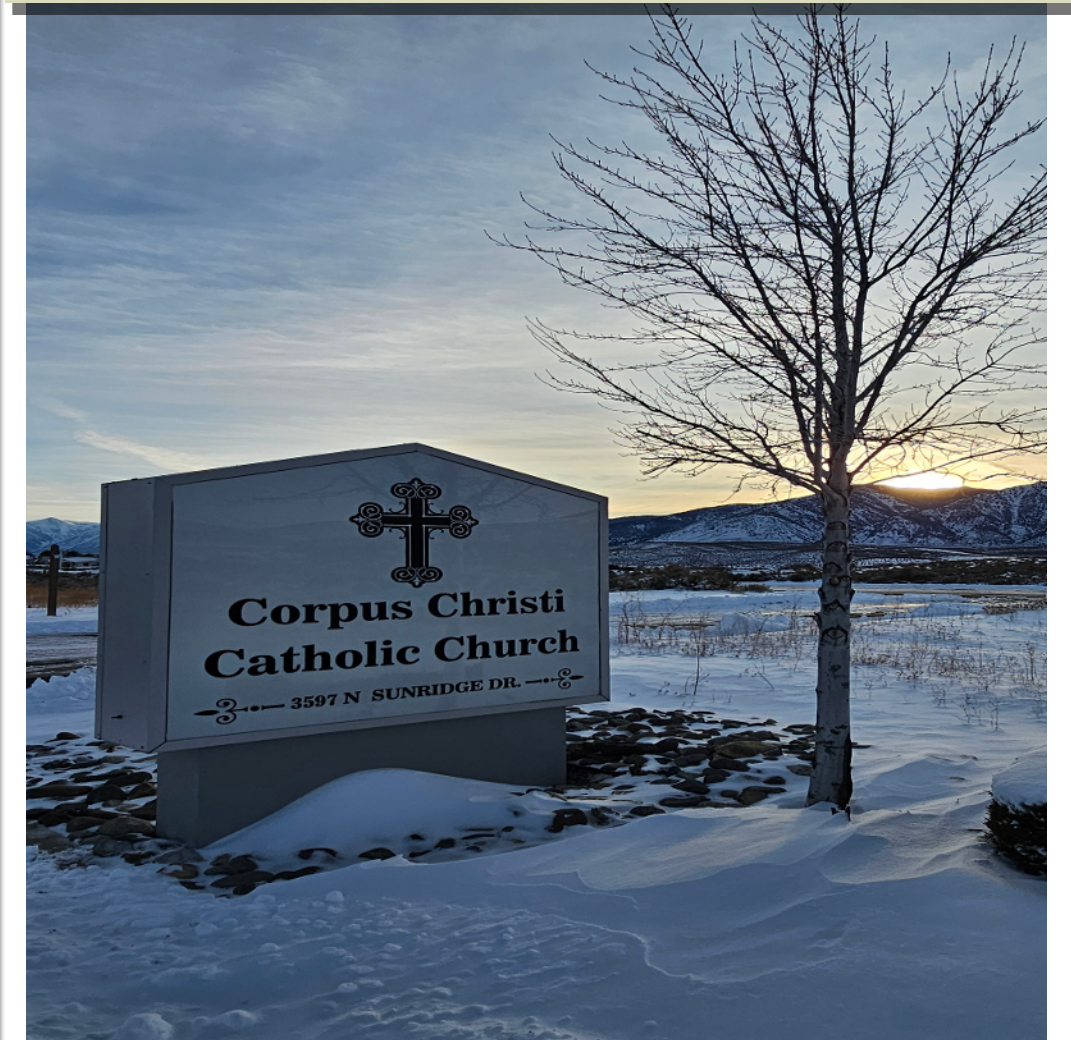

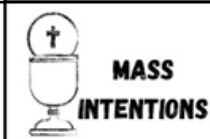

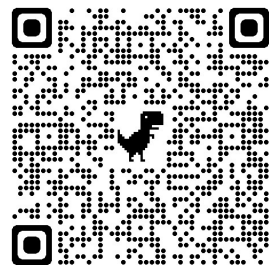

**Eucharistic Revival, Introduction to the Mass:
Eucharistic Prayer #3-Sanctus**

"And they [the seraphim] were calling to one another: 'Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory.' At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke." Isaiah 6:2-4

The 'Sanctus' is a profound moment in the Mass, in which we come to recognize that we are entering into Heaven. As such, we quote two very important passages of the Bible. The first is the acclamation of the angels praising God before the throne of grace. As such, we become cognizant that we are entering into something transcendent, joining our voices to those of angels. The second is the proclamation of blessing to him "who comes in the name of the Lord" (c.f. Psalm 118:26) which was said by the crowds as Christ entered into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. This is the same crowd who five days later would call out to have Christ crucified. And this is something powerful to meditate on—that though we sing with the angels, we cannot ignore the ever present temptation to abandon the Lord when the crowds turn against Him.
