



# FROM THE DIOCESE:

#### Eucharistic Revival, Introduction to the Mass: Eucharistic Prayer #8-The Eucharist as Sacrifice



"Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise."

Hebrews 13:15 NIV

The word "sacrifice" comes from two Latin words which literally mean "to make holy." And something is made holy by being offered to God. Thus, when we speak of 'sacrifice' we speak of a ritual action by which something is offered to God. We see this in the life of Christ in his death, resurrection, and ascension. Christ begins the ritual offering at the Last Supper, offers His life on the Cross, rises from the dead to conquer death, and finally ascends, completing the sacrifice by going to the Father. In the Eucharist, we are made present to this entire sacrifice of Christ–To Christ in the upper room at the Last Supper, to Christ dying on the cross, to Christ risen from the dead, and Christ ascending to the Father. This is the reason these events are always mentioned in the Eucharistic prayer.

When you receive the Eucharist, what part of Christ's sacrifice do you relate to most keenly?

His passion? His resurrection? His ascension?
