Eucharistic Revival, Introduction to the Mass:

Eucharistic Prayer #10-The Mystery of Faith

"When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your death, O Lord, until you come again." Excerpt from the Roman Missal

After the words of Consecration, the priest will proclaim "The Mystery of Faith." However, when the priest proclaims those words, he isn't inviting the people to say what the mystery of faith is. Rather, he is declaring that the Mystery of Faith is present here and now; he is speaking of the Eucharist on the altar. The Eucharist is the mystery of our faith. The response we make is our belief in what that means for us: That Christ's sacrifice and our participation in it through the Eucharist brings us life. How are you participating in the death and resurrection of Christ at this moment in your life?
