Eucharistic Revival, Introduction to the Mass:

Eucharistic Prayer #12-Doxology

"Great is the Lord and most worthy of praise; His greatness no one can fathom." -Psalm 145:3 NIV

The final act of the priest in the Eucharistic prayer is the Doxology, in which the paten and chalice are elevated while the priest praises the Father, through, with, and in the Son, in the unity of the Holy Spirit. However, the Eucharist is not elevated so that the people might see it—that took place immediately after the consecration. Rather, during the Doxology, the Eucharist is elevated as an offering to the Father. And it is through the offering of the Son to the Father that we enter into union with Him.

Doxology means literally 'a word of praise.' How do you praise God?
