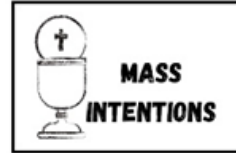

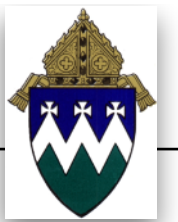

Eucharistic Revival, Introduction to the Mass:

The Lord's Prayer #4-Thy Kingdom Come

"All the way to Heaven is Heaven, because Christ is the Way." -St. Catherine of Sienna

The prayer "Thy kingdom come" has a twofold meaning. First, and foremost, it is the cry of the heart that we might be able to enter into the presence of God for all time in Heaven. It is our desire to participate in the kingdom of God. Second, in a derivative way, it is also a prayer that the world might become a more heavenly place. It is not that we will ever substitute this world for Heaven but rather it is a prayer that the Lord will give us the grace to labor for a world which is guided by the principles of justice and charity—a world guided by the dictates of God's law. Such that even now God's kingdom on earth may be established.
