

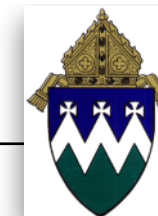

Eucharistic Revival, Introduction to the Mass:

The Lord's Prayer #5—Thy Will be done

"Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done."

— Luke 22:42 NIV

A prayer that is often overlooked, but that is incredibly powerful is the petition "Thy will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven." In this prayer, we place everything we have and are into the hands of the Heavenly Father, and give our permission to Him to guide us wherever He leads. It is both a terrifying and exciting prayer to make—to give God full reign in our lives means we aren't one's in charge anymore, but it is also exciting, because God works all things for the good, and knows what we need more than we ourselves do. It also keeps us from viewing God as a vending machine—putting our prayers in in order to get what we want. Rather, by surrendering our will to the Father, we recognize that He is God, and we are not.
