Eucharistic Revival, Introduction to the Mass: Opening Rites #2-The Sign of the Cross

"I fill up in my flesh what is still lacking in regard to Christ's afflictions, for the sake of his body, which is the Church." Colossians 1:24

The first prayer of the Mass is the humble sign of the Cross. Oftentimes we can think of it as just an introduction, like a person saying "hello" when answering the phone. However, its significance is far greater than just a preface to prayer. In the sign of the Cross, we say in whose name we are acting-the holy name of the Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We are acknowledging that this is no longer something we are doing, but is an action of the divine. And while we say this, we trace the cross over our bodies, reminding ourselves that we must take up our cross and follow Jesus. This is also an incarnational prayer-we pray with our bodies. We aren't disembodied spirits, and as such we bring all of who we are, including our bodies, and offer it to God.

Have you ever thought about the significance of your baptism and its connection to the sign of the Cross? What is your favorite prayer?
