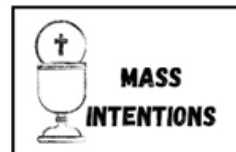

Eucharistic Revival, Introduction to the Mass:

The Lord's Prayer #2—"At the Savior's command..."

"At the Savior's command, and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say"

Excerpt from the Roman Missal

As mentioned last week, fundamentally, the Lord's Prayer is not our prayer, but Christ's prayer. The 'Our' of the Lord's Prayer refers not only to all of us, but it can be understood more deeply to refer also to the Son and the Spirit since they also are always turned toward the Father as source. In other words, when we pray the Lord's Prayer, we participate in the life of the Son and Spirit. This is obviously something beyond our human capacity to achieve; it is only because of the Savior's command that we dare to say it.
